Is this a new kind of filling or an implant?

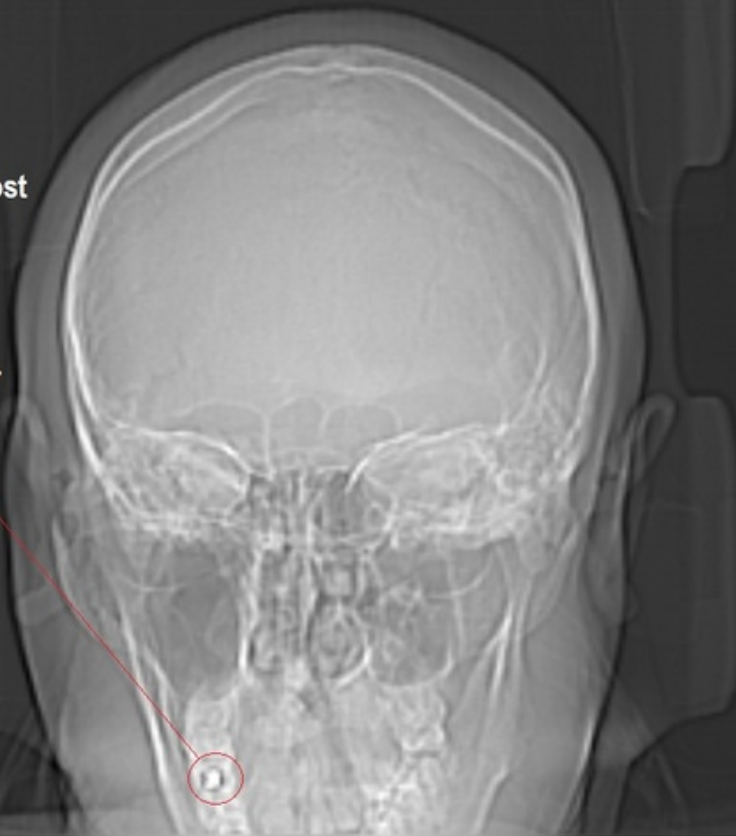
